As prescribed in the last "Incident Action Plan" from the Unified Command at Stevens Facility release on 9/17/2014, I met with Wade Bryant, C-K Associates, and Al Gibson, Jenny Ulmer & Pete Howard, Scientists MDEQ – Compliance and Enforcement Monitoring Section, to access the emergence of vegetation in the wetlands area on 4/21/2014 at 9:05am.

Looking South, the 9/29/2014 was taken from the middle of the wetland, just right of the point on the left...

The assessment was GOOD... The Team observed a variety of wetland and mixed upland plant varieties in the disturbed area... The water was clear and normal with observations of insect, crayfish and frog reproduction activity... We all agreed that the area has recovered satisfactorily... Wade Bryant will work with Al Gibson create the final monitoring report to be circulated to the UC... Please note that the assessment was visual only and no samples were collected... The monitoring

report will include data and photographs observed 4/21/2015, including a comparative report on the biological control points establish in September 2014... 'Plains' goal is to have this report completed by 5/15/2015...

Please let me know if there anything specific that you would like covered in the report... I will forward the final report to everyone upon receipt...
