What is a Tier II Report?

- Information on hazardous chemicals stored at a facility that meet or exceed threshold quantities
- Required by federal and state law
- Environmental and safety hazards posed by the storage of hazardous chemicals
- Information used for emergency planning and response

Tier II Reporting for 2017

- Using the Tier2 Submit software for annual 2017 Tier II Reports
 - Reports must include a customer number (CN), regulated entity number (RN), and TXT2 number
 - Online method to obtain numbers is through STEERS
 - Chemical hazards – new list
 - NAICS codes updated
- Updated website

When to report

- Annual Reporting Period = Jan 1 – March 1, for previous calendar year
- New chemical onsite = within 90 days
- Change in current chemical amount range = 90 days
- Fertilizer grade ammonium nitrate = 72 hrs

TCEQ TIER II ONLINE REPORTING SYSTEM

- Sign up for updates on website – email or text
- Migration of current 2017 data
- Available through STEERS – Tier II Core Data, Tier II Government Official, Tier II Reporting
- Submission Process
 - STEERS sign in
 - Select facilities to edit or create new facilities
 - Submit all facilities at one time
 - System will calculate fee, can be paid online right away or can be billed
 - System provides a receipt of report submission – includes statement that the TCEQ has received your report, a list of facilities reported, and an explanation of fees.
 - System provides exported data files in pdf (paper form) and xml (electronic file) formats, compatible with Tier2Submit and CAMEO
