NARRATIVE

Crews responded to the above address on a barrel with an unknow liquid within in. DCSO requested a fire response and the deputy stated that the day before he was in the parking lot and found a truck being worked on next to the barrel. The deputy was able to locate the tow company that assisted the truck and provide the information of the truck that was towed. DCSO deputy was able to contact the responsible party and stated the barrel is his and he had to drain diesel into the barrel so he could work on his vehicle. The responsible party stated that it is only diesel and some car parts. He also has no intention of returning to get the barrel as he is in Amarillo, Texas. Upon my arrival I was debriefed on the situation and found a blue plastic barrel with approximately a quarter full. With the assistance of Bur13 we attempted to contact the property owner, Property management and leasing agents of the incident with no answer. Bur13 contacted the EPA to see if this incident would fall under the Orphan waster program. The EPA stated they can handle this with no issue. Due to another Hazmat incident both bureau units marked the area with flagging and cleared the scene and responded to the next incident. Later that afternoon EPA contacted Bur 13 and stated that the container was picked up and will be disposed of properly. No other actions were taken by SMFR. DCSO case number for this is 2023-107179.
