MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: Region 8 Predesignated On-Scene Coordinators

TO: U.S. EPA Region 8 Emergency Management Branch and Region 8 Response Section

The National Contingency Plan (NCP), 40 C.F.R. § 300.5, defines the On-Scene Coordinator (OSC) as the federal official predesignated by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency or the U.S. Coast Guard to coordinate and direct responses under the NCP Subpart D (related to discharges of oil to waters of the U.S.) or the government official designated by the lead agency to coordinate and direct removal actions under the NCP Subpart E (related to releases of hazardous substances and/or pollutants/contaminants). This memorandum shall serve to document the predesignated OSCs in U.S. EPA Region 8, in accordance with 40 C.F.R. § 300.120(a).

The EPA OSC job has a specific, unique position description that defines the duties, responsibilities, and expectations of the OSCs. The individuals who currently hold the OSC position and are predesignated for US EPA Region 8 are:
